## STATEMENT OF OBJECTS

- (a) To promote and hold sustainable the internal and external trade, commerce and transport, services and the manufacturers and industries of Byron Bay and surrounding regions.
- (b) To consider all questions connected with such trade, commerce, transport, services, manufacturers and industries.
- (c) To promote support or oppose legislative or other measures affecting such trade, commerce, transport, services, manufacturers and industries.
- (d) To collect and circulate statistics and other information relating to such trade, commerce, transport, services, manufacturers and industries.
- (e) To protect, enhance and hold sustainable our unique physical environment and to acknowledge our stewardship of the environment to ensure its ongoing nurturing and sustainability.
- (f) To promote and protect the cultural diversity and perspectives that make up the community of Byron Bay.
- (g) To work in unison with other community groups for the benefit of the Byron Bay community.
- (h) To undertake training and education for the benefit of members.
- (i) To purchase, lease, hire or otherwise acquire for the purpose of the Association any real or personal property so far as the law may allow and from time to time to sell, demise, let, mortgage or dispose of the same.
- (j) To erect, maintain, improve or alter any building for the purposes of the Association.
- (k) To borrow or raise money by the issue of or upon bonds, debentures, bills of exchange, promissory notes or other obligations or securities of the Association or any mortgage or charge of all or any part of the property of the Association.
- (l) To invest and deal with the moneys of the Association not immediately required upon such securities and in such manner as may from time to time be determined.
- (m) To engage professional assistance of any kind and to remunerate any person for services rendered or to be rendered in or about the formation or promotion of the Association or the conduct of its affairs.
- (n) To raise money by subscription and to grant any rights and privileges to subscribers.
- (o) To do all such things as may be conducive to the extension of trade, commerce, transport, services, manufacturers and industries or incidental to the attainment of the above objects.
